Dear Parents, Teachers, School Administrators, School Board Members, and Concerned Residents:

Due to the recent overwhelming reactions and feedback regarding Common Core, we will be holding a forum dealing with concerns expressed by educators, parents, and other stakeholders regarding the implementation of the new curriculum based on Common Core standards. We are pleased to invite you to participate at our **Western New York forum on Tuesday, November 19, 2013 from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. at the Akron High School Auditorium, 47 Bloomingdale Avenue, Akron.**

Some of the topics we will be covering include:

1. Reactions to the new education standards being promoted by the President and National Governors Association, known as the Common Core. Are there components being left out of the new standards? Are there unnecessary ones?
2. Was the implementation of new curriculum based on Common Core standards handled appropriately? What can be implemented to improve the transition to the new curriculum?
3. How has the new testing associated with Common Core affected students' attitudes toward learning? How has it affected their instruction time and the approach of classroom teachers?
4. What challenges have been presented to local school district administrators, curriculum chairs and principals as a result of the implementation of Common Core?
5. Are there concerns about the safety, privacy and access to demographic, enrollment and state assessment data on schoolchildren kept by InBloom on the New York Education Data Portal?

It is our intention to hear from as many participants as possible, but time constraints may require that those wishing to provide oral testimony provide written testimony only. We will hear from educational officials first, then from parents. If you would like to speak, please sign up on the evening of the event and bring 10 copies of your testimony, including your contact information, to the forum. All written testimony that is submitted will be included in the record and summary that will be prepared at the conclusion of the proceedings.
